EDITORIAL

I would like to thank all those Match Captains who have forwarded me details of matches played, and I hope they will continue to do so. I would like BOTH sides to send in ... results, since I could then check up on some of the names. Most lists have the one side nicely typed out, and the other side filled in in manuscript, and what with scratchings out and so on, it is not easy to make sure of names. Names are essential if the players concerned want to have their records noted by the graders.

On the 14th November the S C C U Jamboree takes place and it is hoped that 20 teams, including some Junior sides, will take part. Details of the results will be published in the next issue,

The last issue, with the S C C U Grading List proved to be very popular, and many copies of the List have been sold separately, but in several instances, the selling of the list has brought in subscriptions for the Bulletin itself. This is very satisfactory, but I feel that more should be done in getting the clubs belonging to Counties to take out a Club subscription, and for individual members playing on, say, the top twenty boards in County matches, being encouraged to subscribe also. Interest in Chess is growing, membership of clubs is on the increase, but very few club players learn anything about the world outside their own club room, and many profess to have no interest in events taking place outside the parish! If chess players could be taught to take a greater interest in the County affairs, and in the Union organisation, and finally the British Chess Federation and its many activities, life would be a lot easier for some officials, and far more stimulating for many many players! Most clubs need more officials to take over some of the organisation, Counties are crying out for helpers to organise tournaments, issue Bulletins etc., and it is the same within the Unions and the B C F. Yet there must be many people who can help, and Counties should make appeals as widely as possible for any help they may need. Stenographers are wanted for meetings; typists are wanted for copying; accounts have to be kept and audited; letters have to be written to people on all sorts of subjects. Retired officials on pension have nothing to do? So they say before retirement! Get them interested in doing jobs. Wives who complain of "nothing to do" let them take minutes of meetings and type stencils and what have you. It doesn't need a good player to become a good helper! Grove Cottage G W Henlen

Very little publicity is being given to the details of the 16th Chess Olympiad at Tel Aviv At the time of writing, it is clear that the three home countries have failed to enter the top pool in the final competition. The BCF team finished third in Group 4 in the preliminary rounds, and thus entered the B section in the finals, as also did Scotland, who finished 4th in their section. Ireland, alas, are in the bottom section. No details of games played by individuals have so far come my way, which is a pity, because with an interest in four of the players, I am sure that many chess players in the SCCU would like to learn how these players showed up.

In this country, an interesting tournament took place at Coventry over the weekend 7th/8th November, for the team and individual championships in lightning chess (ten seconds a move). The final results were pleasing to the S.C.C.U. The winners of the team championship were New Ham and East London (otherwise West Ham), and second were London Cedars, Metropolitan were 5th and the Mushrooms of Surrey equal 7th. Entries numbered 26 and teams consisted of four players who played ten rounds. In the individual championship, M. Macdonald Ross of Middlesex tied with B. Cafferty of Birmingham for first place and M. J. Basman finished 4th. I have seen no details of the result of the Bognor Regis Chess Tournament (40 moves per hour), held during the same week end.
