#### EDITORIAL

First of all I should like to congratulate the Southern Counties' players who took part in the International Team Tournament at Tel Aviv. As you will already know, the B C F team finished 18th out of fifty entries. This was somewhat disappointing, but without Dr J Penrose, it was realised before the competition began that our chances of finishing in the top group were none too good. However, of the six players who participated, C Kottnauer, International Master, of Middlesex played in 18 matches on board No. 1 and won 8 and drew 7 a very good performance. O M Hindle of Norfolk, and M J Franklin were first and second reserve. The former, however, played in 16 matches and finished with the excellent result of 9 wins and 4 draws, whilst Franklin played in six matches, winning four and losing two. We might feel justified in including P H Clarke in the list of "our" players, because it is only recently that he has moved to Northamptonshire, and most of his match play has been for Essex. As usual he drew most of his games, playing twelve times, winning twice and drawing eight. M J Franklin, of Surrey, who has recently become a British Master, seems to have got his foot on the ladder of International Matches, and it is to be hoped that he will be able to give the time to this grade of play in future. O M Hindle, is an obvious natural, at this grade of chess, and as he has made it his profession, we feel sure he will soon become one of Britain's leading players.

More subscribers to the UNION CHESS FARE have come along this month. Do please try to get more! Circulation at the moment is just under 150 and this means that the Bulletin hardly pays its way. ### SCCUJAMBOREE 1964

On the 14th November just over fifty players and their wives and friends sat down to an excellent luncheon at John Lewis Partnership, under the Presidency of Mr. J E C Grant of Hampshire. Mr. A F Stammwitz, Honorary Secretary of the British Chess Federation and Ars. Stammwitz were the guests of honour. Afterwards, the match for the Henlen Trophy began in earnest between twenty teams of ten a side. Ten of the Counties within the Union entered a Senior side, and five of these also entered a Junior team, whilst the Insurance League, the Thames Valley League, and a team from Leicestershire specially invited, plus a team nominated by the President, made up the full score of entrants. When time was called there were several unfinished games, but all bar five were agreed before the players left. The remainder were sent for adjudication, and the final results were known on the 24th November. The winners proved to be the Surrey Juniors. Thus for the second time in the four years of the competition, their name appears on the Trophy. In 1961, the first year for which the Shield was competed, they tied with Essex Seniors, who this year finished second. Scores of the sides involved were:-
