JUNIOR CHESS TRUST FUND APPEAL

Chess is now universally recognised not only as a game, but also as a form of mental and cultural development and there are few schools, colleges or educational establishments that do not feature it in their list of standard activities.

In recent years the British Chess Federation has devoted considerable attention to improving the standard in this country and, as results show, with a fair measure of success, but there is quite a lot more to be done particularly among juniors. To this end there is to be a close examination of the structure of British junior chess with a view to instituting such reforms and reorganisation as are found to be necessary.

Whatever is considered or decided will be governed by financial resources and at the moment these, unfortunately, are sparse.

Accordingly, at their meeting on 25th September, 1965, the B C F Council decided to inaugurate a Junior Chess Trust Fund whose income would be devoted to juniors and junior events and to launch an appeal for donations to this Fund. They also decided that they would match every pound donated with a pound from the Federation's capital, but as this capital is only moderate, this would be to a maximum sum of £ 3,000.

May I draw your attention to this appeal and the benefits that could be conferred on the educational and cultural needs of the youth in this country by the development of organised junior chess, and how much this depends on regular and adequate finance. This is indeed a most deserving and worthy cause and I do hope you will show tangibly your agreement with these views. No amount is too small for, after all, it will be doubled. So will you please send a donation to our Hon: Treasurer, Mr. I Cohen, 48 Beacontree Avenue, Walthamstow, London, E 17.

We look forward to a generous response as we should like to be enabled to put the juniors on a really good footing.

Below them are other players just entering their teens who are equally as good. To get these players to the top, and to turn them into World Champions is something for which those of us who form the bulk of the Union's chess players should do something more than cheer on the side line. It will need money which these players themselves cannot afford to give them the kind of competition which will enable them to reach the top, and those of us who have the wherewithall to donate something towards this Trust Fund should not hesitate to put our hands in our pockets and send something to the B C F Treasurer which will increase the money available for this purpose and, at the same time gladden the heart of our B C F President. So please do not delay.

England v Holland

The International match between the Royal Dutch Chess Federation and the British Chess Federation played over the week end of October 16th and 17th at Fleming's Hotel Half Moon Street, held special interest to players in the Southern Counties because seven of the team belonged to Clubs within the Union. This annual match for the Trophy "the Seven Provinces" was won this year by the visitors by 11½ points to 8½, with a draw between the British Ladies' Champion and the Dutch Ladies' Champion. Pride of place must go to M J Franklin, who, on board 6, won both his games against Professor J T Barendregt. In his first Senior International, M J Basman, on board 10 scored 1½ points, but neither P N Lee nor W R Hartston showed any sign of the form which has brought them into this class, and their double losses, against strong opposition, was disappointing. Dr J Penrose had an excellent win in the second game against J H Donner the Dutch Grand master. Two of the games given below have already appeared in the British Chess Magazine, but, in case some of our readers missed them, I do not apologise for putting them in this Bulletin, together with Mrs. E Pritchard's second game against Mevr. M C Vreeken-Bouman. Whatever happened in the ten board match, Mrs. E Pritchard was under pressure to win this game, having lost the first. O M Hindle on board 7 drew both his games, and C Kottnauer on board 2 drew his first game, but lost the second.

V J Soanes, the non-playing match captain, whilst disappointed with the result, but was satisfied with the manner in which his team tackled such strong opposition. The match was sponsored by Unilever NV and arrangements made were excellent and deserve the highest praise. How pleasant it is to find such a well-known International firm willing help our British team and the B C F to put on a first class show, as this was, with, alas, little publicity in the National Press.
