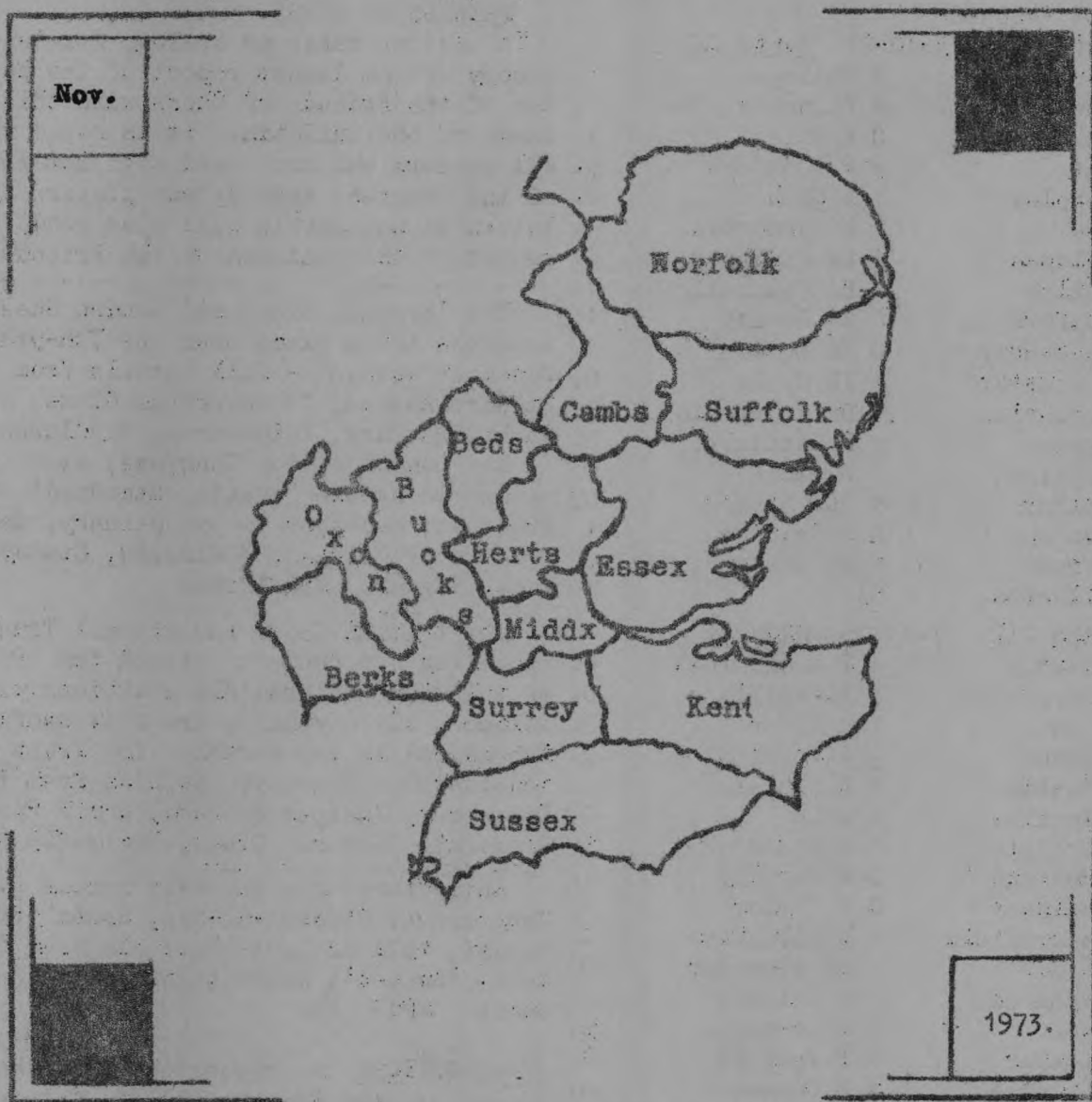

GRADING LISTS The September (Grading List) issue of the Bulletin started life with 1,000 copies which lasted just three weeks. It was followed by a second and final run-off of a further 200 copies, sixty of which are already bespoken.

The Editor takes this opportunity of thanking our producer, Mr Kilmister, for the monumental task of duplicating and collating a total of 1,200 copies, involving 24,000 foolscap sheets from 38 stencils.

CORRESPONDENCE The well-known British Chess Magazine contributor, Mr R.N. Coles, sends his thoughts on the 1973 Grading List: "A breakdown of the 1973 Southern Grading List gives the following figures:-

In Grades 225-237 (International Master Grades) there are six names; in the range 216-224 (British Master Grades) 11 names; 207-215 (National Ratings) there are 26. 201-206, 25; 196-200, 45; 191-196, 47; 186-190, 68; 181-185, 87; 176-180, 108; 171-175, 146; 166-170, 131; 161-165, 182; 156-160, 191; 151-155, 234; 146-150, 241; 141-145, 278; 136-140, 264; 131-135, 245; 126-130, 241; 121-125, 185; 116-120, 164; 111-115, 135; 106-110, 87; 101-105, 63; 96-100, 75; 91-95, 24; 86-90, 28; 81-85, 20; 80 and under 39.

This breakdown may inspire (we hope it will not discourage) those young players who are now setting out to climb the Union ladder, but it also reveals some interesting features. Whilst we all, like Mr Slater, look for the day when an Englishman achieves Grandmaster status, it will be seen that, of the 3,395 graded players, 1,503 (or nearly half) are in the 126-155 range. The peak grades are 137 with 66 names; 134 and 144, each with 63; 143 - 60; 141 - 58; and 140 - 56. Incidentally 137 was the peak in the previous year also with 58 names, the next being 147 with 57.

There seems to be every hope that the large number of extremely promising boys and girls now starting in the lower grades, where there are several more names than last year, will before long push up to the area of densest population from the 125-155 range to the higher levels. This would do quite as much, if not more, for the good of British Chess as having one player regularly graded at 238 or over in the Grandmaster range. So good luck to all young players in the future."

From these and earlier issues of the Bulletin from other Unions, it appears that both the Midlands and ourselves are comparatively unmoved by the new county divisions covering local government, the North seems to be proliferating new chess divisions which might add three or four new county associations to conform to political areas now in being. While this may give new scope for many new administrators in the Northern Chess, it will not cause any loss of sleep by Southern County Match Captains who will look forward to an easier passage once they reach the quarter-final stage of the B.C.F. inter-county Championship.
