Entries are invited for the above event which is for county teams of 6 players and will include 4 sections, entry per team at the indicated price:

Under 18 Open	Grading un-restricted. Open to players born on or after 1 September 1998.	£40	£45
Under 18 Minor	Players' grades, both standard-play and rapid-play must be less than 130. Open to players born on or after 1 September 1998.	£40	£45
Under 14 Open	Grading un-restricted. Open to players born on or after 1 September 2002.	£40	£45
Under 14 Minor	Players' grades, both standard-play and rapid-play must be less than 110. Open to players born on or after 1 September 2002.	£40	£45

Counties may enter no more than two teams per section and no more than four teams in total, unless otherwise agreed by the organisers. The sections will be run as 3 round jamborees with each round having a rate of play of 60 minutes for all moves plus 5 seconds increment per move. Players must have been aged under 14 or under 18, respectively, on 1st September 2016. The January 2017 Grading List will be used for purposes of eligibility.

RESERVES

There is no official provision for reserves in this event. However, if teams choose to bring reserves, some provision will be made for matches between the reserve players. There will be space available in the playing area for such matches.

ECF GRADING

All games, including reserve games, will be sent for ECF standard-play grading.

VENUE, TRANSPORT & ACCOMMODATION

Orleans Park School, Richmond Road, TWICKENHAM. TW1 3BB. There is some limited parking available on-site. Twickenham Station is 10 minutes' walk from the venue, St. Margaret's Station is 15 minutes away, whilst Richmond Station is a short bus journey away from the venue. A number of buses stop right outside (the stop is called "Orleans Park School"), and a great number stop in Twickenham town centre, close by.
